POSITION SUMMARY

The primary purpose of the Wait Staff position is to serve residents during meal service, providing them with the nutritional requirements and customer service needed to ensure an enjoyable dining experience.

POSITION RESPONSIBILITIES INCLUDE:

- Serves plates to residents in the Dining Room.
- Provides and refills beverages for residents.
- Sets tables prior to meals, arranges silverware and napkins, and sets up condiments.
- Takes food orders from residents in the Dining Room.
- Serves plates to residents in the Dining Room.
- Prepares trays for pickup by caregivers for residents dining in their rooms.
- Clears tables after each meal, cleans table and chairs.
- Additional duties as assigned.

QUALIFICATIONS

Education:

Minimum high school diploma or equivalent preferred.

Training and Experience:

Prior experience waiting tables preferred. Excellent verbal communication capabilities and ability to multi-task.

The final candidate must successfully pass The Reutlinger's post offer, pre-employment testing which includes a criminal background check, drug test, COVID test, TB screen test and health screen. All staff, except wait staff and dishwasher positions, must be at least 18 years of age.
